

CHILDREN OF PROMISE CAMP COUNSELOR JOB DESCRIPTION

All Children of Promise Summer Camp Counselors will work under the supervision of the Camp Director and Leadership Team, who will assist them with guiding campers through a daily pre-established schedule of fun and enriching activities. It is the Camp Counselor's responsibility to facilitate and supervise campers' daily activities and contribute to a safe, healthy and nurturing environment in which campers can learn and grow.

Expectations of Children of Promise Camp Counselors:

As a camp staff member you are expected to:

- Be enthusiastic and willing to be fully involved in the camp experience. Remember, you will not only be around children, but will also be living the camp experience with them.
- Create a positive, safe, and supportive environment for all campers. Our focus at camp will be on providing patience, support, guidance, and encouragement at all times.
- Act as an appropriate role model for children through your actions, language, work habits, and general conduct. Camp may be fun and exciting; but it is also a real job and, as such, you are expected to act in a professional manner.
- Be a team player and have the ability to collaborate in a professional manner with colleagues from diverse backgrounds in a way that prioritizes the needs of children.
- Have the ability to positively motivate children and other adults to achieve a common vision.
- Commit to establishing environments that foster creativity and high achievement among children.
- Have experience working with children and families with diverse backgrounds and abilities or be engaged in a course of study in Early Childhood Education or related field.
- Have a strong work ethic (i.e. arrive to work on time, work cooperatively with others, and stay on the job until the work is done).
- Abide by all Department policies, procedures and guidelines.
